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TOP TIPS FOR PLANNING

Have a goal in mind:

Set a goals for your homeschool and each child.

Be familiar with the material.

It helps when searching or adding supplemental projects. Crafts or recipes.

Start an online “folder” for your grade.

When you come across a verse or resource pop it into the folder. Easy to find when needed.

Keep a running list of materials needed

Plan your year “whole to parts”.

Start with the big activities, vacations, main lesson blocks and work down to weekly details.

Do a quarterly and/or semester check-up on your progress.

Are you behind? Right where you should be? Do you need to modify your plan?

Don't try to plan your year all at once.

Take it in steps to avoid overwhelm.

Start planning the upcoming year in spring if possible.

Give yourself time to understand and read the stories and have a feel for what you are bringing to your child.

Sunday prep.

I glance at the upcoming week and refresh myself on what is coming.

Be flexible.

No matter how prepared you are, it will not go exactly as planned.
